The full time position will be based out Nelson, BC. Instrumentation calibration and installation skills and familiarity with PLC and HMI units is expected. Familiarity with basic water quality chemistry is required. You will also update and maintain documentation, logs, etc. pertaining to tests and processes, perform equipment optimization and maintenance, correct minor operating problems and perform other related duties as required and/or assigned.

Qualified candidates are Grade 12 graduates who have completed the Water Quality Technology program or other recognized Operator training program. The successful candidate will be required to have their Level 1 (Or higher) Water Treatment Certificate. Wastewater experience and certification is an asset. A valid Class 5 Motor Vehicle Operator's License is required. Candidates must demonstrate strong initiative, mechanical aptitude, communication skills, report writing, analytical and troubleshooting skills. The operator has to be able to work in a team environment, as well as to work independently. Demonstrated skills in Microsoft Office products, including Excel and Word are an asset. The successful applicant must also be able to meet the physical requirements of the position.

Significant training in advanced water and wastewater treatment technology will be provided to the incumbent. As part of the position on-call and out of town work may be required occasionally, including project support in B.C. and AB.
